**Our bedrock, our foundation**

"Is there any god like God? Are we not at bedrock? Is not this the God who armed me, then aimed me in the right direction? Now I run like a deer; I'm king of the mountain. He shows me how to fight" (Psalm 18:31 MSG)

The *Los Angeles Times* reported (Jan. 10, 2009) that during the calendar year 2008 Southern California experienced 267 earthquakes over 3.0. That's more than one every other day!

I've heard it said that the foundations of the Golden Gate Bridge in San Francisco are very well built. So well built, that the safest place to be if an earthquake hits is in the middle of the bridge.

The Golden Gate Bridge is a structure that could possibly withstand an earthquake of 9.0 on the Richter scale. The bridge is thought to be properly constructed for two reasons. One, it's safe because it's flexible and will sway under earthquake stress. Secondly, the bridge is

considered safe because of its cantilever and suspension construction. Every bit of concrete, pavement, and steel in the entire bridge inter-relates one piece to another. Every piece in the bridge ultimately relates back to two giant cables that connect with two great piers that are secure in bedrock.

That's said to be the genius of this suspension bridge – every single piece of metal and concrete is grounded within its foundation – the bedrock. The bedrock foundation makes the bridge what it is.

Some of my first lessons as a Christian were determining who my bedrock was when the storms of life blew. Many times
